












ROUTE No 1

«PATSOS GORGE»

A HEAVEN ON EARTH WITH
ARCHAEOLOGICAL, CULTURAL AND
NATURAL INTEREST TOTAL ROUTE
LENGTH 4KM or 8KM for those who want to
continue hiking around the lake, after the
end of the gorge

HOW TO GO ON FOOT
We move to the water source of Patsos.

The STARTING POINT (1) is opposite the water source and behind the high tree.

DIRECTION: We follow the concrete narrow downhill road which is behind and under the informative sign.

After 150 m we arrive at point (2), where we see an open cistern (waters) to the left.On the right we see some old houses and the Byzantine church of 14th century a.m.

From there we continue straight following the downhill road for 200 m arriving at a new house surrounded from a stonewall and railing, point (3)

From point (3) we turn left and follow the downhill concrete road for 350 m arriving at an asphalt main road, point (4)

We cross the asphalt road on the opposite side and follow the downhill concrete narrow road arriving outside the building (5) . This is a winery which you can visit .


From there we continue the downhill road for about 100 m until we meet a small asphalt road .point (6).

We turn right and after 100m we see the steep downhill road, where a little further we see a big tavern (Drymos). 100m from tavern arrive at a small square, point (7).

Walking for a while we meet a huge wooden entrance and a path leading after 200 m to the chapel of st Antonios.

The distance from point 1 to point 7 is 1,5 km

ENJOY HIKING








For a few meters the road is straight until we reach point 3, an old stone house on our left. It is called «Mitato», in Cretan dialect, which means a shepherd house that made cheese in the old times.

We continue straight uphill until we reach a junction, point 4.

From there we turn right following the down hill dirt road to point 5 where we turn right again to an uphill path to point 6 where we see an underground reservoir of rainwater called «Sarnitsi» in Cretan dialect. At this point we are able to see clearly the top of Soros. We continue following a rocky path to west direction and in about one hour we reach the top (1.180m), point 7.

The whole route is uphill except for the 4 to point 5.

A HISTORIC SITE / SYMBOL OF PATRIOTISM AND FREEDOM TOTAL ROUTE LENGTH 1.5KM

A route that leads to the hideout named HARAKAS, where the abducted Generral Kreipe from Germany was hidden by the abductors for 2 nights (7 & 8 of May, 1944). Apart from historical interest, the route is covered by dense vegetation and wild beauty of the mountains that surround it. It is a good chance of escape for everybody, due to short distance (1 km) and easy access.

PS: HARAKAS means a huge and towering rock

HOW TO GET THERE

After having enjoyed the traditional Greek coffee with the rustic full breakfast of Mrs. Maria you can fill your flasks with the crystal clear waters of the water spring which is located just beside the "PATSOS" traditional tavern(1).


Then, we follow the uphill paved road which touches the PATSOS traditional tavern, for 50 m (2)

There, we turn right following the concrete road for 40 m(3), then, we turn left following the uphill concrete road for about 200m from where we see a big closed water tank on the right and 50 m further a sheepfold on the left.









The most delicious traditional dishes of Mrs. Maria

Away from mainstream destinations, when you find yourself in Patsos, after a day's exploring you can continue the dream at the small traditional tavern "Patsos", running since 1933. It is located next to the crystal waters of the village fountain. There you will enjoy traditional dishes of Mrs. Maria 's with authentic recipes as she learned it from her own childhood, always including fresh vegetables, meat, eggs, virgin olive oil, all organic and locally produced in family fields.
